

5. MINUTES OF LAST GENERAL MEETING, 1ST FEBRUARY 2023:

5.1. As presented in the March 2023 Buzzer Box.

Moved: Adam Jones, that the minutes be accepted; Seconded: Bob Yates; Carried.

6. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST GENERAL MEETING:

7. PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

7.1. The sad passing of Laurence (Laurie) Leonard (Life Member) on 15 February 2023, just shy of his 92nd birthday; Laurie's funeral will be held at the Enfield Memorial Park, Browning Street, Clearview SA 5085, in the Acacia Reflection Room Chapel at 11:15am on Wednesday, 8 March 2023; Laurie was an active Club member and it was mentioned that he would often to say to members that they 'must bring a car'.

8. SECRETARY'S REPORT:

- 8.1. Sarah reported about general Club matters: The ruling that was passed by the General Membership at the General Meeting on 2 November 2022 had been further considered by the Committee and modified to say that new members are encouraged to present themselves to a General Meeting upon their application for membership, however, they are not required to do so. To coincide with the release of the new Membership Categories, this will come into effect for the 2023/24 financial year, with wording similar to 'Attendance at a General Meeting is encouraged for approval of a new membership application unless the applicant is located in a rural or remote zone according to RRMA classifications or located outside of South Australia' being added to the 2023/24 Membership Application Form. There was no objection by those members present about this change; The annual event to be organised that encourages the inclusion of classic vehicles (e.g., a dedicated run or a combined club run) will be the President's Run; Club Name Badges: Please continue to let the Secretary know (via email) if you have not previously been issued with a badge or require a replacement. For those who have already let the Secretary know, thank you, your advice has been received, and an order will be placed shortly; The usual club magazines were received and forwarded/provided to Neil Hofmeyer for inclusion in the re-established Library.
- 8.2. Sarah reported about temporary Clubroom Hire matters: The Land Rover Register of SA has swapped their regular meeting on Friday, 29 September 2023 to Friday, 22 September 2023; The FX-HZ Holden Club of SA has booked three additional bookings, being Sunday, 16 April 2023 (9:00am 5:00pm), Tuesday, 23 May 2023 (7:00pm 9:30pm), and Tuesday, 27 June 2023 (7:00pm 9:30pm); The Monaro

Club of SA has booked an additional booking for their Registration Day on Sunday, 4 June 2023 (9:30am - 1:00pm); Sarah ran into Jeremy Whitehead, Vice President of the Land Rover Register of SA, today at the Gepps Cross Homemaker Centre and he mentioned that his club is very happy with the setup at Fawk Reserve Hall.

Moved: Sarah Bowshall, that the Secretary's Report be accepted; Seconded: Tony Russell; Carried.

9. NEW MEMBERSHIP:

9.1. An *Associate* membership application was received electronically from Alan Pendleton and partner, Katrina Williams, of Munna Para, initiated through the Club website; the second page of the application that lists vehicle/s was not received; This application was proposed by Sarah Bowshall and seconded by David Dunn.

Moved: Sarah Bowshall, that this membership be accepted; Seconded: Tony Russell; Carried.

10. TREASURER'S REPORT:

- 10.1. The Treasurer outlined the reconciliation of accounts for the month of February 2023; The higher expenditure still reflects the costs associated with establishing Fawk Reserve Hall as our temporary clubrooms; Hiring Clubs paid in advance for 2023, but for accounting purposes, this has been allocated across the two financial years 2022/23 and 2023/24.
- 10.2. Material costs to-date for the hall are approximately \$3,800. Costs are still being finalised and allocated correctly, so a report is still to be completed and will be delivered to the next meeting.

Moved: Kingsley Taylor, that the February 2023 Treasurer's Report be accepted; Seconded: Merwyn Perry; Carried

11. PROJECT MANAGER'S REPORT:

11.1. John Eastick updated members on progress since the last meeting on 1 February 2023: John had a meeting with Council staff this morning, so the status report regarding Croydon is up to date; CROYDON: Council has appointed Architectural firm, SFMA, to undertake the detailed design and documentation of the new build; John said that he had an uplifting meeting this morning with Council and the Architects; The Architects have formed a team of consultant engineers and specialists to assist in the design process; This building is being constructed on a high profile site and this is a significant scenario - it is deemed a challenging site and it will be a 360 degree building (viewable from all four sides); We expect documents for consultation with the Club later in March based on the agreed floor plan; Our specification of finishes and verbal advice provided today; Features: Building move towards the car park by between 1 and 2 metres; Kitchen similar to existing, with stove and rangehood, and room for two fridges and a roller shutter across the servery; Solar panels will be included but the supply of a battery is unlikely, however, there will be provision for this in the future; A modern look with a welcoming feel; Modern materials of construction; A smart building with energy efficiency; A planning application will proceed asap; The current program includes for a construction start in July 2023; The current estimate is close to \$1m on completion; We have established a collaborative team approach; COUNCIL PROCESS: The MTFCA Clubrooms project is embedded in the 2023/24 Budget process; It will be subject to Community Consultation during April and the aim is for the project to be approved in June 2023; The Club is monitoring Government grant opportunities; Arrangements are currently underway to meet with Ward Councillors to lobby our project; FAWK RESERVE HALL: A further Working Bee was conducted last week and all tasks were completed; The establishment phase has now been completed and we move into maintenance phase under the management of Stuart Bowshall; A small number of building defects remain; After two full months of meetings, all clubs are deemed to have settled in; The Committee will still be investigating a number of energy saving options to reduce operational costs; An Exit Plan will be developed to assist with the future move back to Port Road.

12. BUZZER BOX REPORT:

12.1.As both the Secretary and the person producing the current format of the Buzzer Box, Sarah advised the following: Buzzer Box Editor position remains vacant following the Annual General Meeting and is continuing to be advertised in the Buzzer Box; The Committee has decided that moving forward, the Editor can decide whether a monthly or bi-monthly publication is produced; If the bi-monthly option is chosen, the Buzzer Box must include two full-page (A4) spreads of the *Upcoming Events*

Calendar rather than just one to ensure that at least two months' worth of runs and events is provided; Scammells has been notified, both in person and via email, that limited printed copies are being mailed out to members due to our Club currently having no Editor, but that the Buzzer Box is continuing to be distributed to our members and mailing list subscribers electronically; Scammell's is satisfied with this current process; Scammell's has also been notified that once the Editor position if filled, our printing requirements will return to the usual ≈140 copies per publication.

14.1.In Paul Van Ruth's absence, the Secretary reported: Meeting Minutes dated 26 November 2022 have been received and filed; Sarah Clark from the Department of Infrastructure and Transport (DIT; Ph. (08) 7133 2999, dit.sacarclubenquiries@sa.gov.au) spoke at the February 2023 meeting about grant applications; Grants are limited to \$500,000 per year; Eligibility criteria still to be decided; Future information sessions will be organised; A dedicated website will become available once the grant programme has been launched; National Register for eligible left-hand drive vehicles: Such a register is being established and will necessitate changes to the registration process for first time left-hand vehicle registrations in SA; May also affect the importation of left-hand drive vehicles.




CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION **QUIREMENTS**

By law, your historic, prescribed left hand drive, or street rod vehicle is only conditionally registered if:


- 1. Your vehicle has current conditional registration through the Government of South Australia, Department for Infrastructure and Transport; and
 - · For details on obtaining and maintaining conditional registration, please visit https://www.sa.gov.au/topics/driving-and-transport/registration/conditionalregistration/historic-left-hand-drive-and-street-rod-vehicles or speak to an Authorised Person of a recognised motor vehicle club.
- 2. You are a financial member of a recognised motor vehicle club (e.g. the Model T Ford Club of Australia Inc.) within the current financial year; and
 - The Australian financial year begins on 1 July and ends on 30 June the following
 - To join or renew membership for the Model T Ford Club of Australia Inc., a Membership Form must be completed and returned to the Secretary (contact@modeltfordclubaustralia.org.au).
 - Model T Ford Club of Australia Inc. membership forms, including details of membership fees, can be obtained from https://www.modeltfordclubaustralia.org.au/club.
- 3. Within the current financial year, your Log Book has been endorsed (signed and stamped) by an Authorised Person of the recognised motor vehicle club to which you are a financial member.
 - Before your Log Book can be endorsed (signed and stamped):
 - o Your recognised motor vehicle club membership fees must have been paid; and
 - O You must produce your *Certificate of Registration* to the Authorised Person. *Owners of prescribed left hand drive vehicles must also produce their *Left* Hand Drive Exemption (issued by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport).
 - **Owners of prescribed street rod vehicles must also produce their Certificate of Exemption (issued by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport).
 - You must purchase a new Log Book for each vehicle every 3 years at a cost of \$5.00 each.

- You have not completed an entry in your Log Book prior to driving your vehicle.


