



#### 5. MINUTES OF LAST GENERAL MEETING, 2ND NOVEMBER 2022:

#### 8. SECRETARY'S REPORT:

- 8.1. In the Secretary's last-minute absence due to being unwell, there was little to report.
- 8.2. David Dunn advised that ten (10) Hiring Clubs had executed hire agreements for Fawk Reserve Hall.
- 8.3. Club Magazines: The usual magazines have been received and provided to the Librarian.

Moved: John Clarke, that the Secretary's Report be accepted; Seconded: Doretta Hills; Carried.

#### 9. NEW MEMBERSHIPS:

9.1. Nil.

#### 10. TREASURER'S REPORT:

10.1. The Treasurer outlined the reconciliation of accounts for the month of November 2022 and indicated that the Commonwealth Bank is no longer issuing cheque books for the Club. The higher income reflects full annual hire fees paid in advance by Fawk Reserve Hall Hiring Clubs and the higher expenditure reflects the costs associated with establishing Fawk Reserve Hall as our temporary clubrooms.

Moved: Rod Hills, that the November 2022 Treasurer's Report be accepted; Seconded: Merawyn Perry; Carried.

- 10.2. The Treasurer advised that there were several Club stickers and some other memorabilia available, free of cost, after the meeting, on a first come, first served basis.
- 10.3. Car enamel badges are available for \$25 each.
- 10.4. Club shirts are available.
- 10.5. The President advised that the Audit Committee (David Dunn and himself) had audited the Treasurer's books for the 2021/22 financial year and report that they were in order. David advised

that no tax is payable and went onto to thank the Taylor's for their terrific treasury efforts again.

#### 11. PROJECT MANAGER'S REPORT:

- 11.1. John Eastick updated members on progress since the last meeting: the former clubrooms were demolished today and the site cleared; Croydon replacement building concept design had been approved by the Club and a new plan has been provided and circulated at the meeting; the position of the building may vary slightly and verandahs on one or both sides are possible future project(s); the Club has advised the Council of its fit-out and finishes preferences; the Lease for Fawk Reserve Hall is now in operation; the Club has installed the security system from Croydon; the Club has also installed carpet from Croydon and will install a curtain wall – both will mitigate sound within the building; all necessary establishment work is on target to be completed ahead of the first Hiring Club meeting on 9 January 2023; ten (10) Hiring Clubs have been secured and will enjoy the same meeting night as previous; this will also translate to the replacement building; each Hiring Club also receives a storage cupboard and the display cabinets will be reinstated on the walls; Hiring Clubs will attend an Induction Session on Thursday, 15 December 2022; Hall for Hire signs have been installed on the outside of the building which include reference to a temporary email address fawkreservehallhire@gmail.com; a number of working bees have been successfully conducted and thanks are extended to those members that participated; a report about the Croydon replacement building will be considered by the new Council on Monday, 12 December 2023.
- 11.2. John announced that Stuart Bowshall has been re-appointed by the Committee to the position of Building Maintenance Coordinator with effect from 1 January 2023. This was applauded by those members present.

#### 12. RSL BOOKING COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

- 12.1. In Sarah Bowshall's absence, the President advised this is the last Club General Meeting here at the RSL.
- 12.2. John Clarke proposed that the RSL be thanked for assisting all clubs during the year.

#### 13. BUZZER BOX EDITOR'S REPORT:

- 13.1. In Sarah Bowshall's absence, David Dunn advised that a new Editor is required.
- 13.2. In 2023, Sarah is no longer able to commit the time necessary to continue as A/Editor.

#### 14. FEDERATION REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORT:

- 14.1. In Colin Drennan's absence, Paul Van Ruth reported on the last meeting held on Saturday, 26 November 2022.
- 14.2. Paul has effectively taken over from Colin as our Club's representative.
- 14.3. Paul reported that Individually Constructed Vehicles (ICVs) are now included as a category in the Historic Registration Scheme, but it is left to each club to decide if they wish to accept such vehicles; there will be a revised Code of Practice in 2023; the Club's Public Officer is required to sign forms.

#### 15. EVENTS AND RUNS COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

15.1. Adam Jones advised that organisers are required for more runs and events in 2023.

#### **16. PAST EVENTS:**

16.1. The 36<sup>th</sup> Power of the Past on Sunday, 6 November 2022: Organiser, Adam Jones; Rod Hills reported that it was a good day out with a good representation by Club members and their vehicles in attendance. Thanks was extended to Adam.

National Rally: David Carver represented the Club at a meeting of all T Ford Clubs in Australia present at the recent rally in Dubbo, NSW to discuss the future schedule of National Rallies; it was decided that: 2025 in Ballarat, Victoria: 2027 in South Australia (to clear the 100 year anniversary rally for the Ford Model A in 2028): 2029 in Queensland; David Dunn identified that the next rally will be the fifteenth and each attracts an average of 125 vehicles; John Eastick identified that conducting a National Rally has yielded profits that have enabled the Club to undertake building type projects as it previously did at Croydon and currently at Fawk Reserve Hall.


22.1. The Treasurer reminded everyone of the memorabilia items on the table at the back for give away.
